WHEREAS the Vendor is seised of the property hereinafter described
for an estate in fee simple in possession subject to the Lease hereinafter
mentioned but otherwise free from incumbrances and holds the same in trust
for the charity called All Nations Bible College AND WHEREAS the Vendor
has agreed with the Purchaser for the sale of the same to the Purchaser
for the like estate at the price of £2,500 AND WHEREAS by an order endorsed
hereon the Charity Commissioners for England and Wales authorised the
Vendor within six calendar months from the date thereof to execute this
conveyance

NOW IN PURSUANCE of the said Agreement and in consideration of the sum of
£2,500 now paid by the Purchaser to the Vendor (the receipt whereof the
Vendor hereby acknowledges) this Deed witnesseth as follows

The Vendor as trustee hereby conveys unto the Purchaser all that piece or
parcel of land together with the buildings erected thereon or on some part
thereof and known as Taplow Hill House Taplow in the County of Buckingham
which premises are more particularly delineated on the plan attached hereto
and thereon edged red TO HOLD the same unto the Purchaser in fee simple
subject to and with the benefit of the Lease bearing even date herewith
and made between the Vendors of the one part and Span Developments Limited
of the other part

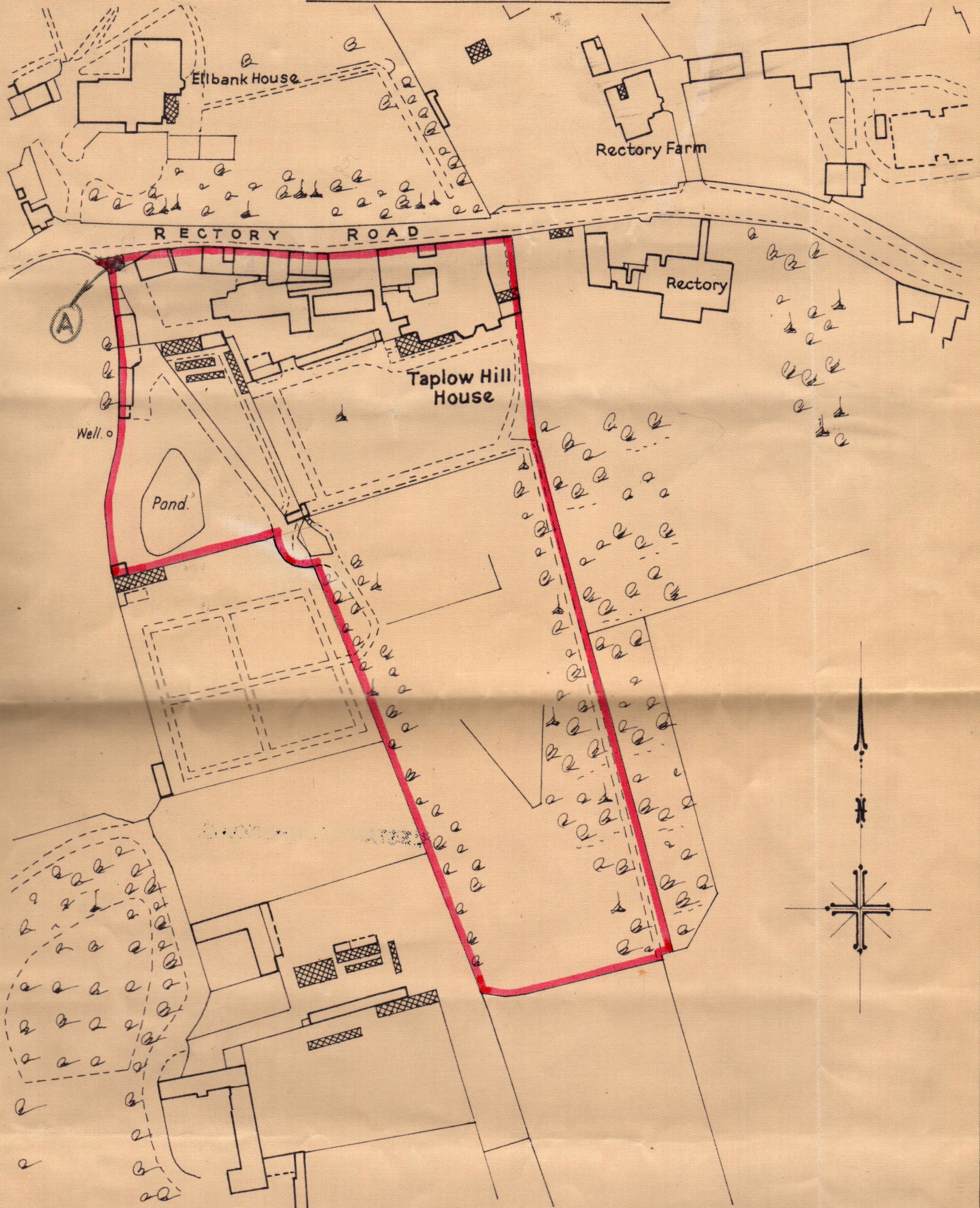
